



BEFORE INSTALLATION


CAUTION: Risk of personal injury. This bathtub is extremely heavy. Obtain sufficient help to lift and move the tub.

IMPORTANT!


- (1) To ensure a successful installation, install the bathtub on a level finished and structurally floor.
- (2) Observe all local plumbing and building codes.
- (3) Check that all parts are included. Make sure you locate all the parts before discarding the carton and packing material.
- (4) Unpack and inspect the bathtub for damage. If there is any missing parts or damage is found, please contact the seller for assistance. Do not install it, return the bathtub to the carton.
- (5) No claims for damages or blemishes will be accepted once tub has been installed.
- (6) Carefully moving the bathtub to the installation area. This bath is heavy and will not easily fit through doorways.
- (7) Provide drain access from below and access to all plumbing connection.
- (8) Because of the weight and volume of the tub, we strongly recommend that this installation be done by qualified licensed professional and with the help of at least one other person, a fall may seem like minor but may result in cracking on tub. Moving straps and rubber gripped gloves are highly recommended.
- (9) Tub drain and brass tailpiece are supplied with the product, however other accessories like slip joint, P-Trap and adapter are not included and must be purchased separately.

INSTALLATION STEPS:


1. Determine the installation location. Position the tub at the desired location, mark the perimeter of the tub with pencil and the location of where the tub drain will be situated, remove the tub, and place it on a soft blanket or cardboard.




2. Install a PVC or brass drainpipe, make sure the drainpipe extends above the finished floor.




3. Place 2 pieces of lumber (4"x4"), long enough to span the width of the tub and place them on each side of the drainpipe to temporary support the tub.




4. Team lift the bathtub on top of the lumber support rails and carefully reposition the tub, so the drain is directly over the drainpipe. Secure brass tail piece to the bottom of the drain or using a flexible drain and gently lower and adjust the tub position to ensure the drainpipe is in the center of the drain hole.



5. Close the drain and fill $\frac{1}{4}$ tub with water, allow the water to stand for 30 minutes, check for leaks. Tighten the drain and tailpiece is needed.
6. Verify the bathtub is level, install shims (not provided) as needed.



7. Apply a bead of silicone caulking around the perimeter of the tub, clean off excess caulking



Care and Maintenance for Solid Surface Bathtub

Your new solid surface tub has been factory sealed and polished to a smooth finish, to maintain the surface and keep it looking fresh and new, it is easy to maintain the finish, however there are few do's and don'ts that need to be aware of, please care this tub in accordance with following care and maintenance tips.

Maintenance Tips:

- (1) If your tub develops minor scratches, they may be removed by scrubbing gently with fine grit sandpaper, a soft brush or non-abrasive sponge and cream cleaner.
- (2) In addition, if the minor scratches remaining after above step or you would like to polish the area in question to its original finish, you may perform following procedure.
 1. Clean the surface with water and make sure no dust remains.
 2. Using water, polish the area starting with 800grit sandpaper then final with 1000 grit sandpaper.
 3. Wipe up remaining wax with clean dry cloth.

Daily Care:

Dos:

- Use warm water to rinse the tub, wipe up water with clean and dry cloth after each use, this will maintain the tub finish and look as new.

Don'ts:

- Do not use any abrasive cleaners, cleaners containing acid, alkaline, ammonia or solvents which will cause damage in the surface.
- Do not expose the surface to hair dye or nail varnish as this may cause stains.

- Bathtub, Whirlpool/Air Bubble Massage Tub, Wooden Cold Plunge: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Toilet and Bidet: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Faucet: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Vanity: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Granite, Marble, Engineered Quartz Vanity Top: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Medicine Cabinet, LED Mirror: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Stainless Steel Sink: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Solid Surface Shower Wall Panel, Shower Base and Vanity Top: 10 Years limited warranty to be free from material defects.
- Shower Door: Lifetime warranty on glass components and 1 Year limited on other hardware.

This limited warranty is non-transferable and only applies to products purchased and installed in the United States and Canada.

This limited warranty excludes all industrial, commercial and business usage. Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) from the original purchaser, Description and pictures of defect, model number or model description must be provided to Woodbridge Bath for all warranty claims and Woodbridge Bath IS NOT responsible for labor cost, removal or installation costs.

This limited warranty shall not apply to goods which have been subject to accident, negligence, improper installation, product abuse, product misuse, or use of cleaners containing abrasives, alcohol or other organic solvents, whether performed by a contractor, service company, or yourself, are excluded from this warranty.

This warranty does not cover surface damaged caused by use of chemicals that break through or dissolve the surface finish or damage caused by the accidental dropping of sharp or heavy objects. Improper care and use of abrasive cleaners and will void the warranty.

During this limited warranty period if a malfunction occurs and after inspection it is determined that a defect developed during normal use, Woodbridge will as at its election proceed with any of the following options:

- (1) repair or replace the defective part(s) or product(s) at cost
- (2) issue a refund of the original purchase price of the product(s) (Valid within 30 days from the date of purchase)
- (3) issue a credit to be applied toward the purchase of a new product. Shipping/delivery charges may apply and are in sole discretion.

Caution:

NEVER use cleaners containing abrasive cleaners, ammonia, bleach, acids, waxes, alcohol, solvents or other products that are not recommended for Chrome finish will void the warranty.

Woodbridge products should be installed by a fully insured and licensed contractor only. Installation by anyone other than fully insured and licensed contractor will void this limited warranty.
